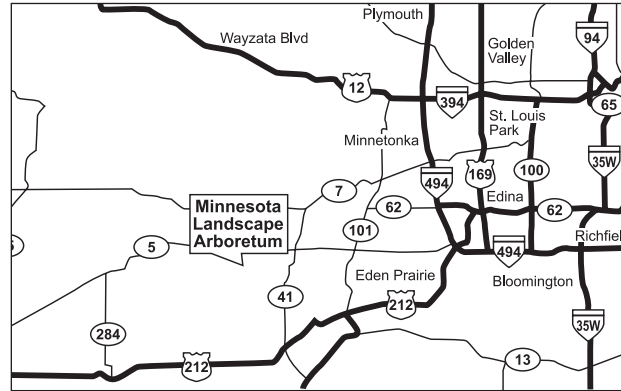
Our meeting will be in the MacMillan Auditorium in the new Visitor Center. After lunch you are free to explore the Arboretum. Must sees: The Snyder building that houses the Meyer-Deats Conservatory, The Gift Shop, and the internationally renowned Anderson Horticulture Library - home to a large and unique collection of books on horticulture, gardening, natural sciences and more; and of course — the beautiful grounds!



The gardens are breathtaking. Explore the Three Mile Drive - on foot, bicycle or by car. The road meanders through the Arboretum and offers views of many of it's gardens, exhibits and collections. For more close-up exploration, walk the 12 miles of paved paths and woodchip hiking trails.

If need be - bring your umbrella. It's beautiful even in the rain.
